







Designation of Origin: NAVARRA

A rosé unlike the typical style of Navarra. Made from Mazuelo—a grape that's notoriously difficult to grow—this wine stands out as a surprising and captivating exception among rosés. It offers pronounced minerality, evocative notes of the countryside and autumn, and a striking floral character.

Vineyard

Grown on the slopes of Montejurra, the vines are bush-trained, organically farmed, dryfarmed, and partly worked with a horse.

Vineyard altitude ranges from 450 to 600 meters.

Winemaking

Crafted by winemaker Jean François Hébrard.

Hand-harvested in 15 kg perforated boxes, with manual grape selection at the winery. Gentle pneumatic pressing.

Spontaneous alcoholic fermentation, followed by bâtonnage on fine lees until February.
