MATURANA TINTA

Despite having been part of Rioja's vineyards since ancient times, this variety was on the verge of extinction.

Its revival was made possible thanks to the Research Project for the Recovery of Minor Native Grape Varieties in the DOCa Rioja. Today, it accounts for just 0.43% of red vineyard plantings in the region.

The foundation of our Maturana Tinta vineyard in Baños comes from 17 vines discovered in an old *majuelo* (traditional small vineyard) in Navarrete, perfectly adapted to the soil and climate conditions of our area. It was planted in 1997.

Maturana Tinta vines produce small clusters with grapes that are high in acidity, intensely colored, and rich in tannic structure. They also show good resistance to vine diseases. The average yield is 5,500 kg of grapes per hectare.

Harvest

Vineyard planted in 1997. Grapes handpicked into 15 kg boxes, manually destemmed.

Aging

11 months in new 500-liter Tronçais French oak barrels.
