One of the first Rioja wines to receive the “Viñedo Singular” back label.

Just 1,200 bottles per vintage—depending on the year—are produced from this unique Garnacha, sourced from the vineyard of the same name. Surrounded by wild thyme, lavender, and fennel, the vineyard is tended through true heroic viticulture due to the extreme difficulty of working the land.

Covering 1.7 hectares at an elevation of 750 meters, the slope reaches gradients of up to 40 percent. The century-old vines that give life to *Cerro La Isa Tinto* are practically bonsai-like, as the poor soil offers little more.

Harvest

Singular vineyard planted in 1906. Grapes handpicked into 15 kg boxes, manually destemmed.

Aging

18 months in 500-liter barrels made from some of France’s finest oak.
