- **Location:** Barillas, Cintruénigo, and Fitero
- **Soils:** Alluvial and clay
- **Farming:** Organic

Vinification & Ageing

- **Harvest:** Manual
- **Yeasts:** Indigenous
- **Fermentation:** In barrels, on lees, with native grape yeasts
- **Extraction:** Manual pigeage
- **Ageing:**
 - 10 months in French oak barrels
 - 8 months in cement tanks
